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Our Aims and Objectives

- To provide a safe, caring, stimulating, and positive environment. We nurture each child to flourish in their own individual way. We support them to reach their full potential by recognizing their own unique starting point.

- To offer monthly training to staff to ensure their personal/professional development



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How our Nursery works

At Little Circle Nursery, we aim to provide a positive stimulating, imaginative and caring environment for children. Once You enroll children into the nursery, parents will receive an EY (Early Years) group. This allows parents to know what is going on with their children. Parents will receive updates in the form of pictures or videos, so that can observe day to day activities of children during their day at Little Circle.

These observations are also linked to daily diaries with information regarding children like, how long they have slept, activities they have been part in, this will also inform about feeds/nappies, what foods they have eaten, etc.

- The nursery is divided into 3 rooms which are separated by age.
- Infant area – 8 weeks to 1 year
- Toddler area – 1 year to 2 years
- Kids area – 3 years to School



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Areas

Infant area (2months – 1 year)

Little circle has a state-of-the-art daycare room with enormous sensory activities for the development of children. The unit is headed by a qualified nurse followed by other assistants with pediatric experience. We have a minimum child-staff ratio, for individual attention and care. We maintain the record of each day of every baby like daily sleeping time, food and toileting routine to pass the information to parents.



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2. Toddler area (1 - 2 years)

At the little circle, we ensure to keep toddlers active and busy to learn through play. For toddlers, we have spacious classrooms with themed zones. We encourage activities tabletop, circle time, Puzzles and puppets, blocks, and flashcards to engage their young minds.

3. Foundation Classes (3+ years)

We emphasize on children to be active learners and develop skills that prepare them for proper school and understand the world. Here we develop social skills, confidence, self-help skills, and independence also the ability to listen attentively and respond to proper communication



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Teacher – Parents Coordination

At Little circle, we understand that a child's education starts at home. it's understood that children will find it hard to remember what they have done during the day and this incomplete information will leave parents feeling completely out of touch with their learning experience. Therefore, we believe to share the learning journey of each day with their parents to have an effective education through document learning like Maintaining dairies, Daily timetables, Using technology to update (WhatsApp, Facebook, Instagram, and email, etc).



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Security – How is my child kept safe?

The security of your children is important to us. All our staff members are very well trained and responsible for safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of children. Each Staff member is alert, and reports, anything that constitutes inappropriate behavior

- The entrance door of the Nursery will be closed always. Parents/Guardian can gain entrance through the front doorbell
- Parents will off in register a log book while receiving the child or children.
- We also carry out regular fire drills to ensure that in case of an emergency the safety of the children is paramount, therefore, children are prepared in what action to take. Fire alarms, smoke detectors, and emergency lighting are fitted to aid rapid escape.
- Safe and hygienic floor coverings, which are fully HSE compliant for wet testing and work surfaces are fitted as standard.



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- Temperature is very well controlled to avoid any sickness
 - All windows/glass in the Nursery are fitted with locks
 - All staff have required and relevant qualifications to commencing work with us.
 - All areas throughout the Nursery are subjected to rigorous risk assessments.
 - Throughout the Nursery, no child will be left unattended



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Hygiene

We strongly promote the policy of hygiene. Especially during Covid, we understood the value of keeping our environment clean and how cleanliness saves people from infections. We stress the concept of cleanliness of the center as well as our children. For this purpose, additional staff is appointed to maintain a clean and positive environment along with assisting the children in the washroom. We ensure that the center is disinfected daily along with frequent hand washing and hand sanitizing among children as well as staff to stop the spread of germs. For this purpose, we buy some decent products like floor disinfectants, alcoholic wipes, Water and hydrogen peroxide mixture, Hand sanitizers. Additionally, we also take care that any employees involved in preparing meals and snacks are certified in food handling.
